SPEECH OF THE GRANDMASTER AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE EXERCHATE OF GREECE IN PIRAEUS 29.6.2019

Esteemed dames and knights of the Order, Ladies and gentlemen,

I am happy to attend again an annual meeting and to address the esteemed knighthood of the OCM Greece.

Unfortunately the Exarchate of Greece has suffered in recent years from a light depression, but I am pleased to notice, that the situation is stabilized, the knightly atmosphere is refastened, new valuable members are recruited, and everybody is in good mood. It all goes to show, that the Hellenic exarchate will prosper again.

Recently I joined the annual meeting of the Exarchate of Finland in Helsinki. The Finnish knights had special reason to celeprate a 60-years anniversary: very 60 years ago, in 1959, the first Finn was accepted member of the Konstantiner-Verein (Association of Constantine) – actually that was the name of our organization in those early years.

The first Finnish member of the OCM was the nobleman Yrjö von Grönhagen, who is well known also to many Greek members of our Order. Very soon von Grönhagen became assistant of the first leader of the Konstaniner-Verein, Risvhard Gruyer-Frey, putting his brains and energy into the sublime aim to develop from the organization an international Christian and Ecumenical chivalric Order.

After almost ten years, and last not least with wise support of his friend the late Metropolitan Eirinaios, he saw his great vision realized:

on May the 12th, 1970 Nicolaos VI, Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, took the Ordo Sancti Constantini Magni under his spiritual protection, thus granting the OCM the legal status of an international Christian Ecumenical Order.

Since then the OCM has considered the charitable support of the Greek-Orthodox Patriarchate of Alexandria as the Order's obliging mission.

All patriarchal successors, the Patriarch Partneios III, the Pastriarch Petros VII and last His Beatitude Theodoros II have blessedly acknowledged the OCM's efforts and have renewed the spiritual protection, which I wish to mention with gratefulness.

From my point of view the Exarchate of Greece has its own position inside the OCM: geographically and also religiously the Greeks are closer to the Patriarchate of Alexandria than

any other unit of the Order, so being a natural link the to the Patriarchate. For many years our friend and great Constantinian knight George Haramis had personally taken care of the diplomatic contacts between the Patriarchate and the government of the OCM. We deeply regret his unexpectedly tragic death and we are thankful for his manifold services for the Order.

Now, we open a new page of the books: his Beatitude Theodoros II has nominated Exarch Vassilis Yannakakos his representative to the OCM, and I from my side have appointed Mr. Yannakakos the Order's ambassador to the Patriarchate. I have no doubt, that you will operate this double-job to the satisfaction of both sides, and I wish you much success.

Finally, coming to the festive ceremony of tonight, I should like to welcome warmly the new dames and knights to the Order, and I take the liberty to do it with the vow given by Yrjö von Grönhagen. He gave his vow of admission in written form to the council of the association, as it was the rule in those early years of the OCM:

"be always conscious to support the goals of our Order to the best of your knowledge and belief". This commitment, of course, ties all our members.

Ladies and gentlemen, I like to express my thanks for the invitation and to enjoy together with you this festive event. And i wish all participants a wonderful evening in friendship and chivalrousness.
